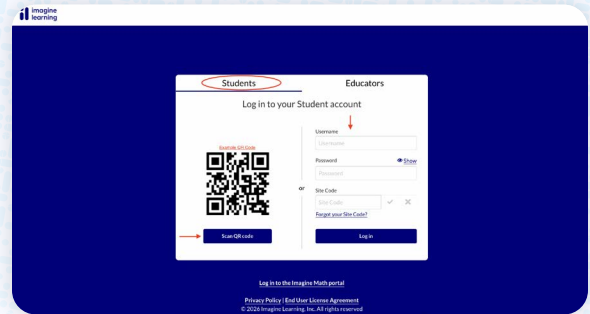


Growing Strong Readers and Writers Starts Here

GET STARTED!

Students will log in to Dragonfly using the username/password combination or QR code provided by their school.

If your district uses a single sign-on (SSO) portal, such as Clever or ClassLink, follow the instructions provided by your student's teacher.



Once logged in, students can access content assigned to them by their teacher. Students can explore literacy content designed to build foundational reading, writing, speaking, and listening skills.

How to Support Learning at Home

If your student wants to continue learning with Dragonfly beyond the classroom, consider these tips:

- Choose a comfortable, distraction-free learning space.
- Create a routine that includes focused work time and breaks.
- Ensure your student has access to Wi-Fi and a charged device, such as a laptop or tablet.
- Ask your student questions such as:
 - What is your favorite activity in Dragonfly?
 - What story do you like best?
 - What was your favorite part of today's lesson?

These conversations help reinforce learning and encourage students to reflect on their progress.

Connecting with Your Student's Teacher

Communicating regularly with your student's teacher helps create a strong support system for learning and keeps you informed on your student's progress. Teachers can provide guidance about upcoming assignments and ways to support your student outside of school.
